

FIVE BROTHERS SERVING—A fine example of patriotism has been shown by the sons of Mrs. E. Daly, of 112, High Street. Mrs. Daly's second son, Robert William, who is 27 years of age and who held the post of Assistant Inspector of Licenses in the London County Council Offices, joined the 6th Royal West Kent Regiment. He went through the

course of training and was sent to France. He is now a Lance-Corporal and has been reported missing since the 7th October. His brother Daniel, also employed in the London County Council Offices, joined the 7th City of London Regiment, has been out in France for 16 months and has been wounded four times. By a strange co-incidence he was wounded for the fourth time on the same day that his brother Robert was reported missing. Thomas Morris Daly is a sergeant in the Army Service Corps, and has been in Egypt for 12 months, and John Patrick Daly is also serving his country as a sergeant in the Royal Engineers, while a fifth son, Edmund Daly, aged 16, has joined the Navy. Their only sister, Miss Catherine Daly, is a teacher at Northfleet Catholic School. To have five sons all "doing their bit" must be a source of great pride to the mother and we hope that Mrs. Daly will favourably receive news of the safety of her missing son, Robert.
